TO DISCUSS WITH CAMPERS

Wear name badges at all times

It is your meal ticket, schedule, and a great way to keep up with keys.

Given States Keep up with room key and dorm card If lost, your church will be charged \$25 for a key and \$10 for a card.

Only use cell phones in dorms, during free time, or when instructed

If seen during classes, choir rehearsals, or worship, they will be taken and given to the group leader.

Respect property and leadership This includes other adults and JoyWorks staff. Damages to campus will be charged to your church.

Participate in all activities, rehearsals, and worship

Participation in camp activities is not optional.

Remain in appropriate camp areas Students should not leave dorms after lights out or campus unless checked out with administration by parents. A good rule of thumb for them is that if you do not see a JoyWorks staffer or their sponsor in an area then you should not be there either.
